

# OPEN DOORS

At the beginning of 2020, Faith (right and cover) was living in a small rental home with her children, husband, and parents. She had to walk more than 20 minutes each way for clean water. She earned about \$40 month. But, Faith was also a new graduate of TOLI's Business Basics Course, and had just received a \$300 microloan to help build her small store.

By the end of 2020, Faith had constructed a new permanent home on land she now owns — a home with separate rooms, plenty of space, and next to clean water. Faith has successfully expanded her business and paid off her loan. Her income has more than doubled. And even her faith grew, as she began reading the Bible regularly with her family.

In a year when the world shut down, it was a year doors opened up for Faith — to her new business, her own home, a new life.

And it was a year of open doors for TOLI, too. The challenge of the pandemic opened doors we'd never dreamed of, through our COVID-19 Relief Initiative and new Bible distribution program. And it strengthened and sharpened us in ways we didn't know we needed.

Of course, COVID-19 interrupted our program and our clients' livelihoods for a painfully long time. But as you'll see in this report, we didn't stop serving. We didn't stop trusting. And we didn't stop worshipping God — who alone is able to bring good out of evil, blessing out of a curse. And who alone opens the door to life abudant, restored, and eternal.

# **BUSINESS GROWTH**

Before TOLI, Faith earned about \$40 per month, working primarily in "casual labor," or day labor. Now, Faith earns more than twice that amount at \$103 per month. She even employs others. "I used to do a lot of casual work," she says, "... but now I offer casual work to other people."

Her experience is typical among TOLI clients:

# STABLE HOUSEHOLDS

With new steady income, Faith stabilized her household, building a permanent home and paying school fees for her kids — an impact that most TOLI clients experience:

92% of clients made improvements to their home after TOLI\*

79% of clients used profits from TOLI businesses to pay for school fees

71% of clients started saving for the first time

## STRONGER FAITH

As a new client Faith received her very own Bible, in her native language. She tells us that since joining TOLI her spiritual life has grown.

And she's not alone. This year, a majority of TOLI clients either made a new decision for Christ, reported a stronger faith, or increased church attendance.

71% report a stronger faith in Christ\*

280 Bibles were provided — both print and solar-powered audio for non-literate clients

# COVID-19 RELIEF

When COVID hit, we acted quickly to help TOLI communities cope. In April, we launched a Face Mask Project, hiring clients to sew thousands of face masks, which our partners then distributed for free in the communities we serve.

Faith was one of those clients, producing hundreds of face masks. The project allowed her to earn vital income while business at her shop was interrupted.

We also worked hand in hand with our Partner Ministries to provide emergency food aid to TOLI families in need.

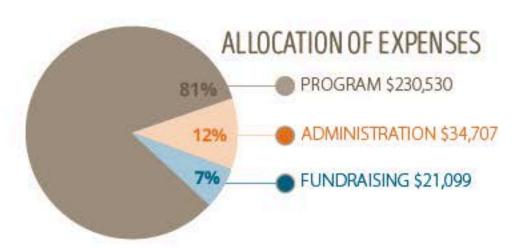


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# 99% OF OVERHEAD COSTS COVERED BY SPONSORS

This year, \$55,175 of administration and fundraising costs were covered through generous donations from our corporate sponsors, including in-kind contributions of \$14,175. That means nearly every donor dollar was directly invested in programming.



- > PROGRAM expenses are invested in direct partner support for our microloan program, such as loan capital, grants for field staff salaries, medical program donations, business training, accountability visits and monitoring, and program staff costs.
- > ADMINISTRATION expenses are invested in operational support, including accounting, bank services, information technology, and communications.
- > FUNDRAISING expenses are invested in telling others about how God is at work through TOLI, inviting others to join us in this kingdom work, and sharing stories of transformation through TOLI around the world.
